Subject: **Notice of Construction** – 4-inch Water Main Replacement on Gromer Terrace (3400 block).
Project I-1079.

Dear Resident:

Crescenta Valley Water District (CVWD) will construct 280 LF of a new 6-inch water main on Gromer Terrace (3400 block). This is part of CVWD's ongoing pipeline replacement program (see project location map on reverse side).

Construction is anticipated to begin the week of November 25, 2024. CVWD crews will begin replacing the old 4-inch diameter water main on Gromer Terrace. The water main was installed in 1948 and will be replaced with a new 6-inch diameter water main. Please visit CVWD's website at www.cvwd.com for updates on the construction schedule. We anticipate the entire pipeline replacement project to be completed by December 13, 2024.

Please note that there will be a period, usually between 4 to 6 hours, when the water service to your home will be shut off. This will occur when crews tie the new water main into the existing water main. CVWD will notify each resident a minimum of 48 hours before the actual shutdown, with a letter that indicates the date and time. Please sign up for Everbridge notifications on our website for the most up-to-date shutdown information.

CVWD crews will install temporary parking and traffic restrictions along Gromer Terrace and New York Ave. This will allow our crews to work in a safe and expeditious manner to complete the project. Temporary "No Parking" signs will be posted a minimum of two (2) days before construction. We request that you observe these signs and any other traffic control. Driveways within the construction zone may be temporarily restricted due to the construction. Construction crews will be on-site at 7:00am, with work beginning at 7:30am. To minimize the impact on your schedule and avoid delays, it is recommended that you utilize parking beyond the construction zone prior to 7:30am, as crews can take up to thirty (30) minutes to reposition heavy equipment and provide access out of your driveway. CVWD's on-site inspector and crew are committed to minimizing this impact and will assist you with access into and out of your driveway.

As in most construction projects, the work will create a certain amount of unavoidable public inconvenience. Your cooperation in making this project successful will be greatly appreciated.
