

WATER OUTAGE ALERT - UPDATE 7/29/18 @ 12:00pm:

A 16-inch water main was hit by SCE's sub-contractor while installing new power poles near the intersection of Raymond Ave and Los Olivos, behind Rosemont Middle School. CVWD crews have temporarily repaired the pipeline for the remainder of the day.

At 10:00 pm tonight, the 16-inch water main **will be shut down again** to make a permanent repair on the pipe. Water will be off in the following areas shown below **from 10:00 pm on July 29, 2018 to 7:00 am on July 30, 2018** to allow the crews to complete the repair. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause.
